Hallie Hearnese holds both a B.S. in Historic Preservation and an M.A. in Public History, with a concentration in Historic Preservation and has a broad range of experience ranging from architectural surveys and condition assessments to complete building documentation. At CRA, Hallie serves as Architectural Historian, based in the Knoxville, Tennessee office. She assists with projects in Tennessee, Arkansas, Virginia, Kentucky, Indiana, North Carolina, Ohio, West Virginia, and Louisiana, and any area serviced by CRA. Hallie has also taken a leadership role in the recent project to prepare design guidelines updates for the Knox MPC, routinely meeting with community representatives and Historic Zoning Commission staff in order to facilitate the completion of documents that appropriately reflect community needs.

Prior to coming to CRA, Hallie served as a graduate research assistant in the MTSU Center for Historic Preservation at Middle Tennessee State University. In this capacity, she was responsible for completing National Register Nominations, creating historic structures reports, guiding historic resource surveys, crafting architectural descriptions, and designing and creating websites on topics of regional historical interest.

During her time at the MTSU Center for Historic Preservation, Hallie Hearnese also completed an extensive study of Mesker pressed metal and cast-iron storefronts. Her thesis outlined the history, identification, preservation, and significance of the mass-produced catalog-order components distributed by Mesker Brothers Iron Works of St. Louis, Missouri and George L. Mesker & Co. of Evansville, Indiana. Hallie has recognized experience and expertise in the identification, preservation, and documentation of Mesker storefronts across the country. She presented her work at the Annual Meeting of the Southeast Chapter of the Society of Architectural Historians in the fall of 2010 and continues to document these uniquely American commercial buildings.

In the summer of 2010, Hallie served as a cultural resources intern in Great Smoky Mountains National Park, in Gatlinburg, Tennessee.
