<p>Ms. Andrews is a preservationist with extensive experience in community relations, fieldwork, interpretive content, and project management. She is highly skilled in research and writing, bringing experience from the field of publishing to complement her training in historic preservation. As an architectural historian at CRA, Jenny's responsibilities include researching and documenting historic properties by conducting archival research and field surveys, evaluating the significance of historic properties, and preparing written reports that provide summary findings and recommendations. Her project work also includes context development, cultural landscape documentation, development of interpretive products, and preservation planning.</p> <p>Jenny Andrews holds an M.A. in History from Middle Tennessee State University, with a concentration in Public History and an emphasis on historic preservation and cultural resource management. While at MTSU her coursework included historic preservation, cultural resource management, American architectural history, and public archaeology, as well as academic courses in Native American, African American, and women's history. She participated in workshops on cemetery preservation, digital history, and archives management, and produced academic papers and projects that examined such topics as rural churches and schools, the history of women in landscape architecture, the recreation and interpretation of a nineteenth-century kitchen garden, extant historic structures in a suburbanizing rural Tennessee community, and the utilization of cultural resources associated with local park landscapes to foster historic preservation and community engagement. Prior to working for CRA she conducted research for MTSU's Center for Historic Preservation and worked as an architectural historian with Thomason and Associates in Nashville.
